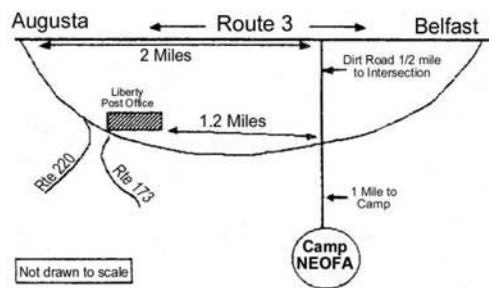

East on Rte. 3 to junction of Rte. 220. Rte 220 to Rte. 173 to Liberty, Maine Continue from Liberty Post Office 1.2 miles to right hand turn onto North Trotting Park Road to Camp NEOFA.

From Belfast, Maine:
West on Rte. 3, after passing Maine State Rest Area on right, take next left (through the islands) to Camp sign on the left. Turn left onto North Trotting Park Road to Camp NEOFA.
